Sea/River-mud analysis with TOT for Bio-Inputs preparation-Team are on the move to equip the poor farm-families with Organic Farming Process so as they can save their land and green views here lost by the Aila-flood-water full of salinity.11 Eco-Farmers Club have been formed to challenge the upcoming events as results of recent Climate Change.Local Natural Resource Management through Farmers' School of Learning is on a good progress to follow and learn..!



While a CDC(Community Delivery Centre) to promote Institutional Safe-Delivery in the rural revirine island block area of Kultali can serve the needy pregnant mothers to



have safe birth of the ir baby. The Deptt. of Health & F W, Govt. of West Bengal under RCH-II has ex-

tended the support to initiate such facilities. It's really a blessing to the rural mothers who used to have their child's birth in an unhygenic & unsafe place of a hut for a time immemorial. This is almost a door-step service to the rural pregnant mothers. There has a provision of JSY supports as declared by the Govt. of India. It has been inaugurated by the District Administration (CMOH) personnels in presence of the BMOH & local PRI Pradhan on dated 28th, June, 2010 and at the BTS-CDC there has been done 13th safe delivery of P-Mothers in the opening month.
